As with everyone, 2020 has been a year of many hurdles but also some very impressive accomplishments.

As you may know, 2020 changed our entire adoption platform. HALO is an all foster based organization. Meaning we have no facility or shelter and all of our animals are fostered in loving homes opened up to us by our communities members. HALO relies strongly on our local pet stores to hold our adoption events and have a place to show our adoptable animals cared for in those foster homes. With Covid-19 that all came to a screeching halt..

To keep crowds down our adoption venues were forced to end all adoption events in order to protect our community from spreading the virus.

Fortunately, we have a very dedicated team of foster parents!! In order to continue to help our animals find their forever homes our amazing fosters and team members revamped our entire adoption process and decided to open up their homes, their front yards and their garages to offer safe & sanitized adoptions! Safety protocols were ALWAYS followed and our deserving animals were able to find their forever families safely!

Despite all challenges HALO was able to place 335 cats & dogs into loving, lifelong homes!!! If that's not an accomplishment during a worldwide pandemic, we don't know what is!

HALO still does not have a date to resume our regular adoption events however, we know that with our dedicated members we will continue to rescue animals in need and see lots of cats and dogs being placed in their forever homes in the next year!

## Finding a Kitten

Kitten season is raptly approaching, here are some tips if you find an infant kitten (eyes and ears closed).

- Keep him/her warm. You can use bottled water warmed in the microwave.
- Feed it warm formula purchased at local pet store or just water if you
  can't get to the store. Using water only is for extreme emergencies
  only and can only be used for a very short period of time. A kitten can
  not survive on water alone and needs formula ASAP.
- If you buy a bottle, cut the nipple just so it drips. A very small hole.
- Feed it every two to three hours.
- Stimulate peeing/pooping by blotting gently on genitalia's.

## SPOTLIGHT ON DUKE

Meet Duke. This big love bug is just that, he is full of cuddles and rubs. He loves to play with his toys with you or chew on his cow hoove. Duke doesn't really like being around other dogs, he wants you to himself. He loves being in the house with you and his family. He enjoys going for car rides and for short walks, due to his weight he is walking short distances for now to lose some and doing very well. Duke will just come up to you and lie next to your feet and hope to get some loving from you; he really is hoping to get belly rubs. Duke is just starving for love and attention and he really deserves it because he is a great dog. He sleeps well in his crate and loves

to sleep with you near your bed or in your bed. He is house trained on the potty pads now and always uses them, but he will also go outside. If you have children he would like them to be 8 years of age or older so that they won't be so rough on him. He doesn't like to be left at home all day alone, being alone for a few hours would be fine or a stay at home parent would be great for him. Duke is ready to go to his new home and get lots of love.

Duke is neutered, microchipped and up to date on shots. Dukes adoption fees are being sponsored.



The Little Troopers Fund is a special program dedicated to raising money for treatable dogs and cats that are in urgent need of medical care. Through the Little Troopers Fund, H.A.L.O. foster animals with special needs obtain the care they would not otherwise receive.

As an animal rescue organization, H.A.L.O. takes in a variety of animals that make great companions for their human counterparts. While many of these animals are healthy, some dogs and cats that come into the program are in physical duress or have existing health problems. Little Trooper Fund enables H.A.L.O. to provide these animals with a second chance.

## Meet Lemonade:

Lemonade and two siblings were rescued from living in the bushes at a local restaurant with a very busy parking lot and against a busy road. The odds were against them. Luckily they were rescued and their journey with H.A.L.O. began. After being rescued it was obvious that the little boy who would be named Lemonade had a badly injured tail.

After a trip to the vet it was determined that his tail was badly infected. There was damage that was too far gone and he had to undergo a tail amputation (Surgery #1). Lemonade went back to his foster home with only 3 inches of tail remaining and some stitches. Foster parents were excited for his recovery! Ten days later it was off to the vet again to have his stitches removed. Unfortunately, the excitement of Lemonades recovery dissipated after we were informed that lemonades infection had continued and it was keeping his incision site from healing.

Unfortunately, he had to immediately have another 2 inches of tail amputated (Surgery #2). With only 1 inch of tail left, he remained in the hospital for two nights post-op. He was then discharged and able to go back to his foster home. However, just a few short days later he was brought back into the vet with more symptoms. Despite the countless hours of wound care provided by his very dedicated foster mom Lemonades infection was just not resolving and the vets just couldn't understand why. After several more weeks this poor boy was back in for surgery #3 to open his tail area back up and do a whole internal cleaning.

Lemonade has been undergoing treatment for almost 2 months now and it seems that we have finally gotten this under control. His "tail stub" has movement and stood upright for the first time since we've had him in our program!

He has been such a champ through all of this and has remained in good spirits.

The best part? Lemonade has found his forever home!

H.A.L.O. takes pride in providing the very best medical care for our animals. Helping animals like Lemonade who's lives depend on medical intervention is a large part of what we do. But of course that doesn't come without a great deal of medical bills.

Although, Lemonade has found his forever home we still have accumulated many vet bills. We are asking, if you are in a position, to please help with a donation towards Lemonades care cost. No donation is too small! Even just \$5, the cost of a cup of coffee, helps tremendously.
